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# CURRENT SCOPE OF ACTIVITIES

What is currently going on in FIL?

In November 2019, the kick-off meeting took place in Arad, Romania, to talk about the future development of the project. The partnership met again, this time in an online meeting via Skype, on the 17th of February 2020, to discuss about the current state of the content of the project.

At the moment, the partnership is developing the content of the modules for the intellectual output 1 and 2. The first one is a training course called "Finances in Everyday Life!" and the second one is a guide for adult educators entitled "Have a nice journey! On the way to improve basic skills". The modules of output 1 are:

1. "My money are mine - how can I manage my budget - basics of finance".
2. Oh, no! Another bill to pay! - how can I count my expenditures".
3. "The bank is not as black as it is painted - how to read financial documents".
4. "Assessing learners' skills and competences"
5. "Creating awareness on validation of the acquired competences".

Sounds interesting, doesn't it? Module 2 will be accompanied by short videos recorded with the use of Digital Story Telling (DST) and everything will be shared using Open Educational Resources (OER)!
