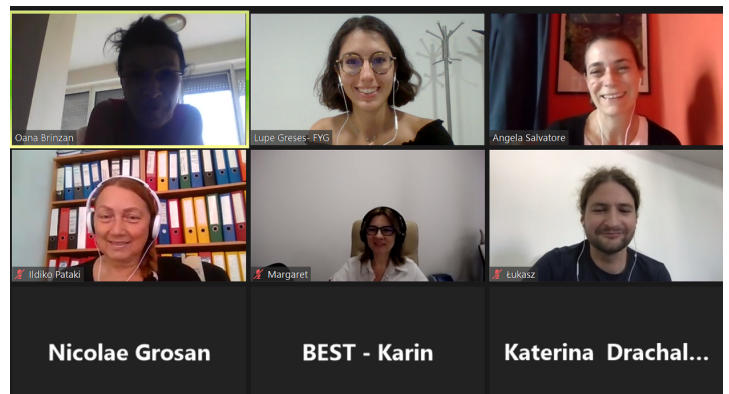

## WHAT HAS BEEN ACHIEVED SO FAR?

- We have **finished the modules for IO1**. These modules are entitled: 1) "My money are mine - how can I manage my budget – basics of finance", 2) "Oh, no! Another bill to pay! - how can I count my expenditures", "3)The bank is not as black as it is painted - how to read financial documents", 4)"Assessing learners' skills and competences" and 5) "Creating awareness on validation of the acquired competences".

- On the 22nd of September we held the **Second Transnational Meeting**, It was held via videoconferencing due to the situation with COVID-19. It was a very enriching meeting, where we talked about the completion of IO1 and the next steps regarding IO2.



# NEXT STEPS



- The next steps of the project are related to the **pilot testing** of the above modules. Each partner will test the modules with 20 adult educators from their country, to **check the content and the quality of IO1**. We will organise this activity online, sending surveys and questionnaires and offering them support with any question they may have.
- Moreover, the partnership has been discussing about **IO2**. This output will produce a guide entitled "**Guide for Adult Educators- Have a nice journey, on the way to improve basic skills**".
- This guide will be developed during November, December and January and it will contain **tips** and information about **how to use the Open Educational Resource (OER)**. It will include a didactic framework with assessment and useful tips for training in a very user-friendly tone.
- Also, a **booklet** or infographic will be designed to sum up the main information of the guide. This booklet will include the **most important tips** in the form of "always do this" and "never do this".
